<p>Summary of the exemption</p>	<p>On March 13, 2020, the Government Office's recommendations come into force, which means that all educational institutions are prevented from having teacherled teaching in the classroom.</p> <p>This exemption only applies to theoretical training in accordance with 147.A.300 and described procedures in the MTOE only apply to the time when the DG CAA- Republic of Bulgaria makes recommendations for physical absence in common school premises in order to conduct theoretical distance learning instead. The exemption with distance learning is made in order for the students to be able to achieve Theoretical Training and the decision is valid from the date of application for distance learning and 6 months further on, and not longer than 30 November 2020.</p> <p>No exceptions will be allowed for examinations, practical assessments and practical training.</p> <p>The DG CAA- Republic of Bulgaria requests an audit status plan from each individual 147 organization.</p>	
<p>Reasons for granting it</p>	<p>Urgent unforeseeable circumstances</p>	<p>The COVID-19 outbreak has resulted in drastic travel restrictions and closure of borders between a majority of States. This might impact the possibility to perform the theoretical training. The outbreak and risk of spread of Coronavirus COVID-19 has resulted in need for distance learning instead of teacher-led teaching in classroom.</p>
<p>Summary of mitigating measures</p>	<p>Safety, environmental protection</p>	



	<p>In order to benefit from the Exemption the organization managing the training organization approved in accordance with Part 147 must ensure that the following mitigating measures are complied with:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Maintenance training organization shall be already approved to carry out Annex III (Part-66) aircraft type and/or task training, subject to compliance with the standard specified in point 66.A.45; and 2. The organization shall provide an amended exposition for use by the organization describing the organization and its procedures and containing detailed information about performance of distance learning synchronous; 3. The maintenance training organization's exposition and any subsequent amendments concerned distance learning shall be approved by the DG CAA- Republic of Bulgaria; 4. The maintenance training organization shall provide training need analyses for each theoretical training course and influence of distance learning, regarding concerned duration of the course; 5. The maintenance training organization shall provide access to web platform used for distance learning to the DG CAA- Republic of Bulgaria; 6. The maintenance training organization shall provide information to the DG CAA- Republic of Bulgaria for the period of each theoretical course, based on distance learning technique before the start of the course; 7. DG CAA- Republic of Bulgaria could perform an ad-hoc audit to distance learning theoretical training course at any time. 8. The maintenance training organization shall apply any additional requirements, if any, issued by the DG CAA- Republic of Bulgaria and EASA.
