This might impact the possibility to perform the physical survey of an aircraft which is part of the airworthiness review. In accordance with Regulation (EU) 1321/2014, the airworthiness review is mandatory when the ARC had been already extended twice. In such case lack of an airworthiness review would result in expiry of the ARC.
	Urgent operational needs	As a result of the of the extreme operational and resource constraints caused by the COVID-19 outbreak, it is needed to apply this exemption when the said circumstances are declared to the Directorate General "Civil Aviation Administration" of Republic of Bulgaria by the organization that manages the continuing airworthiness of the aircraft (approved in accordance with Part-M Subpart G, Part-CAMO or Part-CAO ) to ensure a certain level of business continuity ( e.g. avoiding expiration of the ARC).
