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 (1) Holders of class ratings, type ratings, instrument ratings, mountain ratings or language proficiency endorsements benefiting from point (a) of this exemption (see field "Summary of the exemption") shall comply with all of the following: (a) they shall hold a valid relevant rating and, if applicable, a valid language proficiency endorsement; (b) they shall, during the application period of this Exemption, have received a briefing from an instructor who holds relevant instructional privileges in order to refresh the required level of theoretical knowledge to safely operate the applicable class or type and to safely carry out the relevant manoeuvres and procedures, as applicable. That briefing shall include class – or type – specific abnormal and emergency procedures, as appropriate. (2) Upon successful completion of the briefing as per point (b), the new expiry date of the relevant rating and, if applicable, the language proficiency endorsement, shall be indicated in one of the following methods: (a) it shall be endorsed in the licence of the pilot by one of the following:
